

Telephone Calling Features

Anonymous Call Rejection (*77 to Activate/*87 to Deactivate)

If it bothers you that someone call but blocked their number from being sent to you, Anonymously Call Rejection (ACR) lets you block these types of calls. Your phone will not even ring! When you have ACR, the anonymous callers hear a recorded message telling them: "We are sorry the party you have dialed is not accepting your call at this time."

Selective Call Acceptance (*64)

Selective Call Acceptance allows you to create a list of up to six (6) numbers you want to accept calls from. Only these (6) numbers will ring on your line. When someone not on your list tries to call, they will receive a recorded message that you are not accepting calls from them at this time.

Do Not Disturb (*78)

Allows the subscriber to block there phone line temporarily to prevent incoming calls.

Find Me-Follow Me (*371 to Activate/*372 to Deactivate)

Use a single number to ring all your phone numbers: home, work and cell.

Call Waiting

Allows you to receive a call while on another call. Depress switchhook to answer 2nd call (or hang-up if finished with the 1st call). Depress switchhook to alternate between calls.

Cancel Call Waiting

If a feature which allows you to temporarily prevent, on a per-call basis, any incoming call from being call-waited on the line. Before making call, dial #70. The incoming call will receive a busy signal. During a call (requires Three-Way Calling) depress the switchhook, then dial #70.

Call Forwarding

Permits you to transfer incoming calls to another number of your choice. Dial *72, listen for three beeps and a steady dial tone, then dial telephone number to forward to. Hang up, or stay on the phone, wait for ringing and advise party of call forwarding. To cancel, dial *73, listen for three beeps, then hang up.

Three-Way Calling

Lets you turn an everyday two-way phone call into a three-way conversation. While on one call, depress switchhook, dial third party's telephone number. If third party answers, depress switchhook. If busy or no answer, depress switchhook twice to reconnect first call.

Speed Calling

Allows you to call up to eight (8) of your most frequently dialed numbers, just by dialing a one digit code. To set up, dial *74, listen for three beeps and a steady dial tone. Enter code (2-9), then dial desired telephone number. Listen for three beeps, then hang up. To use, dial desired speed calling code.

Personal Ringing

Allows you to have up to three (3) numbers with unique ringing patterns. Provides advantages of additional lines, but at a fraction of cost.

Toll Denial Service

Restricts your phone from accessing the long distance telecommunications network while permitting you to access the local exchange network.

Call Block

Permits you to block an incoming call and/or calls from a maximum of eight (8) specified numbers and functions as a screening service.

Call Return

Allows you to automatically redial the telephone number of the most recently completed incoming local call or call attempt by dialing an activation code (*69).

Priority Call

Is a feature that allows you to preselect a maximum of eight (8) telephone numbers that can be given a distinctive alerting signal, ring or call waiting tone for priority calls.

Repeat Dialing

Permits you to automatically redial the last outgoing telephone number dialed. If the redialed number is busy, hang up, dial *66, then hang up again and the called number will be monitored for a specific number of minutes in an attempt to establish the call.

Call Trace

Allows you to automatically request a trace of an obscene, threatening or harassing call. After receiving such a call, hang up. Then lift the receiver and listen for dial tone. Press *57, then listen for tone or announcement. You should then call your telephone company if you want the call to be investigated further.

Caller ID Service Offers

Calling Number Delivery and Anonymous Call Rejection. Calling Number Delivery allows you to see the phone number of most incoming direct dialed calls and some long distance calls before answering (required special telephone equipment). Anonymous Call Rejection permits you to automatically reject calls from callers who have blocked the delivery of their telephone numbers.
