Scholarship application time is now

It's only the second month of the young new year, and though it might not seem possible, the time for spring commencement for high school seniors in the region is only short months away.

Applications must be fully completed, legibly typed or written, have no attachments other

than the photo and two required letters of recommendation, and must be received at the offices of WT Services, Inc. P.O. Box 1776, Hereford, Texas 79045, no later than April 10, 2018.

Applicants may be asked to attend an interview at the discretion of the WTRT board.
